Clay Fire Territory is seeking highly motivated children who want to learn about the career of a Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technician. Over the course of the 5-day Summer Camp, these Junior Firefighters/EMTs will have the opportunity to see what first responders do on a regular basis. Campers will learn about the history of the fire service, the different types of fire trucks and equipment, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), fire prevention, search and rescue, technical rescue, and hazardous materials. Our program is focused on teaching team building skills, while allowing the campers to get a "hands on" view of how to handle an emergency. Campers will leave with valuable skills such as; how to use a fire extinguisher, starting the steps of Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), treating injuries and preparing a patient to be taken to the hospital, and fire safety tips to assist with preventing a fire in their home. At the end of the week, all campers will participate in a graduation and receive a certificate of completion.
