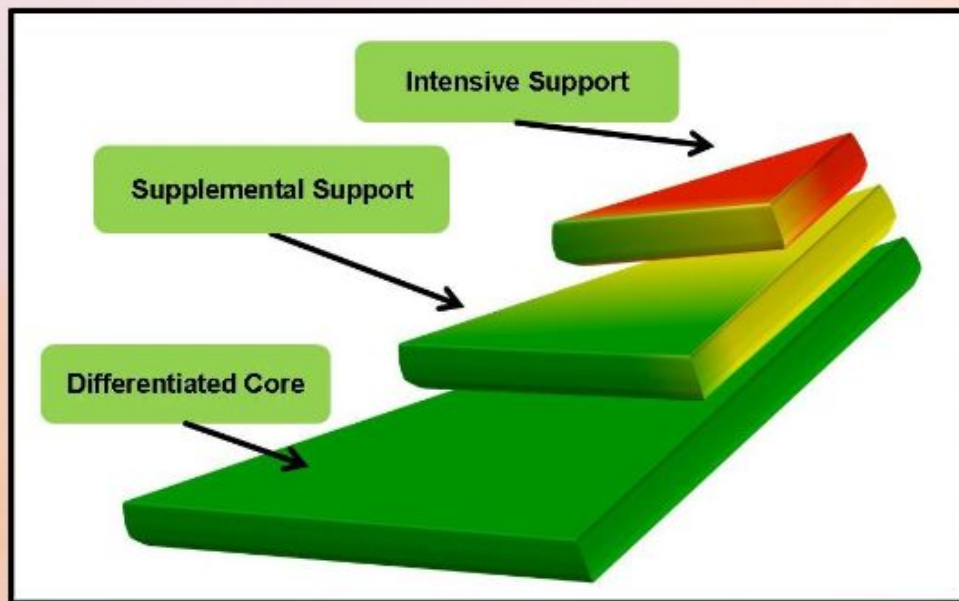
ONGOING CONVERSATIONS ABOUT STUDENTS AND PROGRESS

RtI Process at all Levels



Reminder:

Students do not fall into a category of Tier 1, 2, or 3. They receive layers of support as needed. A student in Tier 3 will receive Tier 1 & 2 support in addition to Tier 3 interventions.



Tier 1: Differentiated Core (80-90% of students) Every student receives universal supports

Tier 2: Supplemental Support (5-10% of students) Some students ALSO receive targeted supports

Tier 3: Intensive Support (1-5% of students) Few students ALSO receive intensive support
