Per the public health order from the St. Joseph County Health Department, staff and students are required to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth.

Students and staff should do their best to practice social distancing, attempting to maintain six feet between individuals whenever possible.

CATEGORY	CONSIDERATIONS
Arrival	<p>OUTDOOR SUPERVISION:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Staff will be strategically placed around the building for student safety and supervision. <p>BUSES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Upon arrival, buses will unload 1 at a time with supervision. <p>CARS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Upon arrival, students will exit their vehicle as directed by staff.● Parents are to remain in their vehicles. <p>UPON ARRIVAL TO CLASSROOMS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students will wash their hands/utilize hand sanitizer.● Lunch boxes will remain in a specified location within the classroom.
Breakfast	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students who eat breakfast at school will have it delivered to the classroom by Food Services. Students will eat in their classrooms.
Restroom Breaks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Restroom breaks to be determined by each grade level in a schedule that allows social distancing. (K-2; 3-5). Grades K-1: 1st grade restroom Grades 2-3: 1st grade restroom Grades 4-5: Office restroom Preschool: Locker Room● Handwashing protocols will be emphasized.● Students will follow the same directional movements for entering and exiting (use of arrows, wait spots etc.) .

<p>Hallway</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students should stay to the right while in the hallways. ● When 2 people meet at a doorway, the person exiting has the “right of way.” ● Students moving in lines will maintain social distancing. ● Drinking fountains will be used as bottle filling stations only.
<p>Classroom Environment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All furniture impeding social distancing will be removed from the classroom. ● Determine best use of space which allows social distancing. ● Shared materials and manipulatives will be sanitized between uses. ● Portable/flexible seating allowed/encouraged ● Label individual student materials. ● Sitspots purchased for K-5 (1 set per class) to provide visuals for adequate social distancing. <p>SPECIAL AREAS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● IMC: Procedures will be put in place to monitor classroom libraries and allow for safe handling of books. ● PE: Outside when possible. ● MUSIC: Shared instruments will be sanitized between uses.
<p>Technology</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will be assigned Chromebooks (1:1) and headphones with no common/sharing computers in use. ● Daily sanitizing of devices.
<p>Instructional Practices</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Core instruction will include the consideration for learning gaps. ● Priority given to grade level standards. ● Consider whole group classroom interventions prior to interim/benchmark testing. ● Utilize formative assessments to determine gaps in learning. ● Utilize online formats.
<p>Lunch</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Handwashing protocols will be emphasized both pre & post lunch (two hand washing stations will be added to the cafe). ● Masks may be removed once students are socially distanced, seated and ready to eat. ● All seats will be assigned. ● All lunches are pre-packaged (if purchased at school). ● All surfaces disinfected between groups. ● Eating outside on nice days is an option.

Recess	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Each area will be sanitized after each use prior to the next group of children. ● Communal sports equipment will not be available for use. ● Students will wash their hands after recess. ● Playground will be divided into sections: Playground (includes equipment) & Field. The grade levels permitted to use the playground equipment or area will rotate. ● Staff will work to create a list of recess game options and exercise activities to help with social distancing.
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Kids Club will be called first and students will report to the gymnasium. ● Bus riders will then be dismissed, called by individual bus. Students will exit the door nearest their classroom. ● Dependent on the number of car riders as evidenced by parent survey data, dismissal options will be evaluated. ● Parents are to remain in their vehicles during this time.
