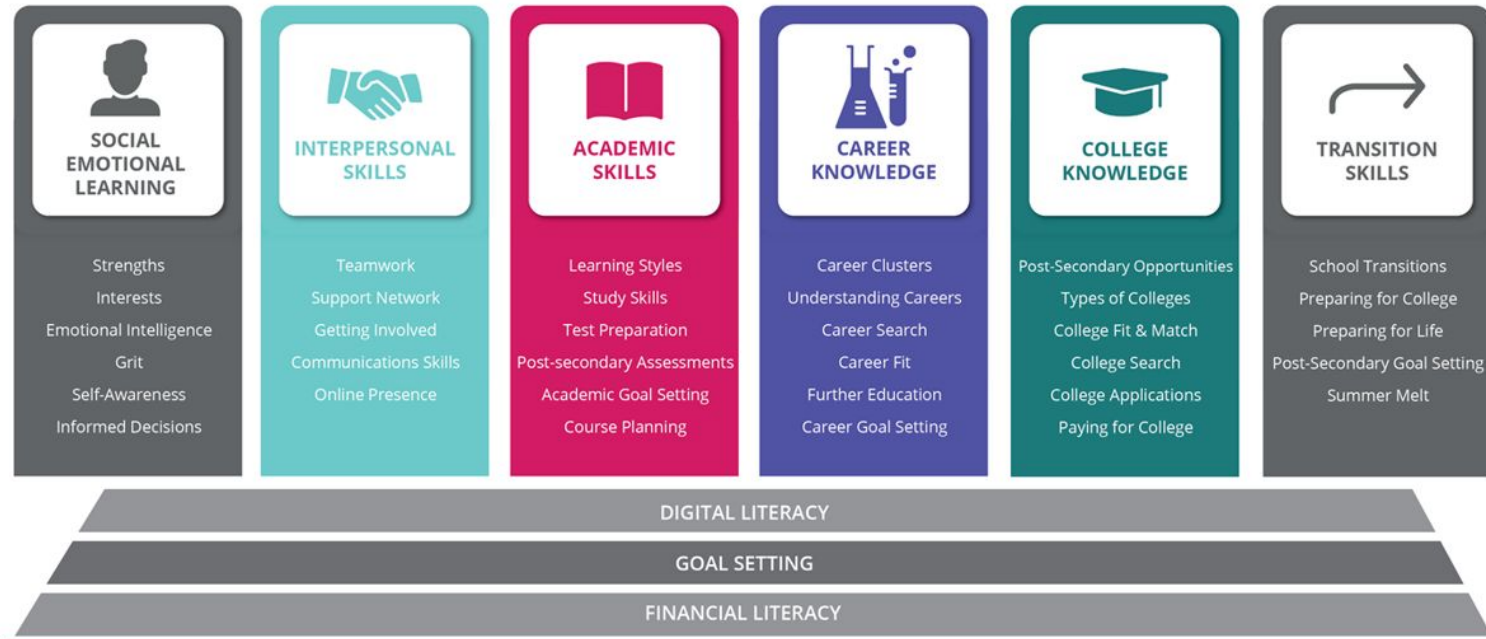
The focus is on College, Career, & Life Readiness (CCLR).

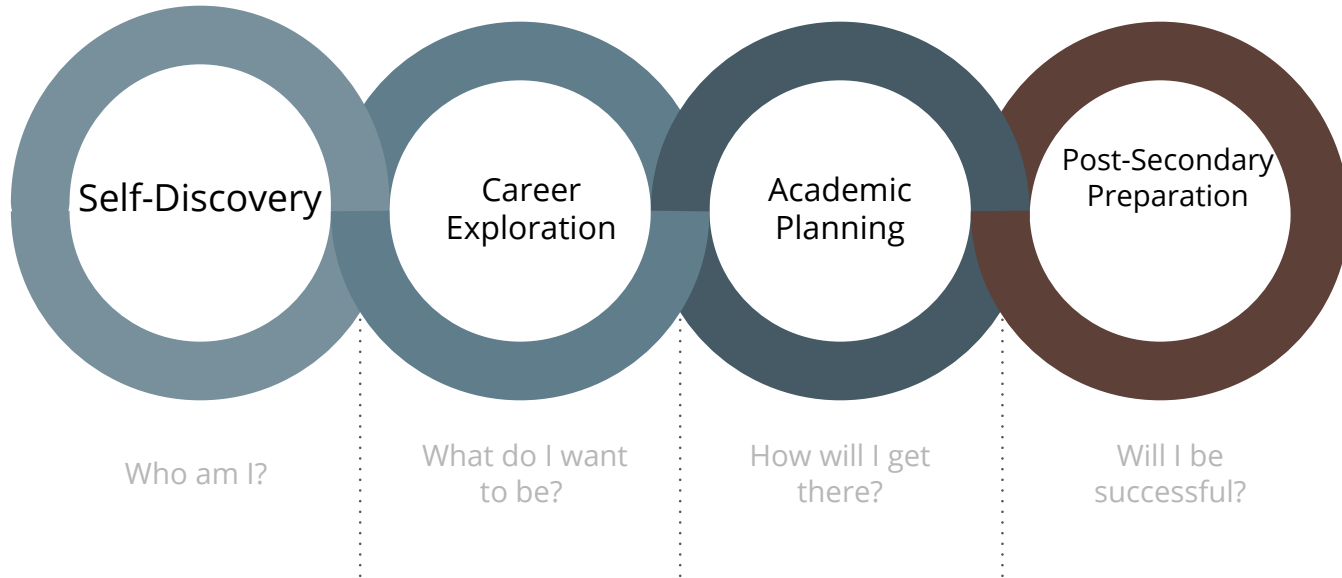

Student Lifecycle



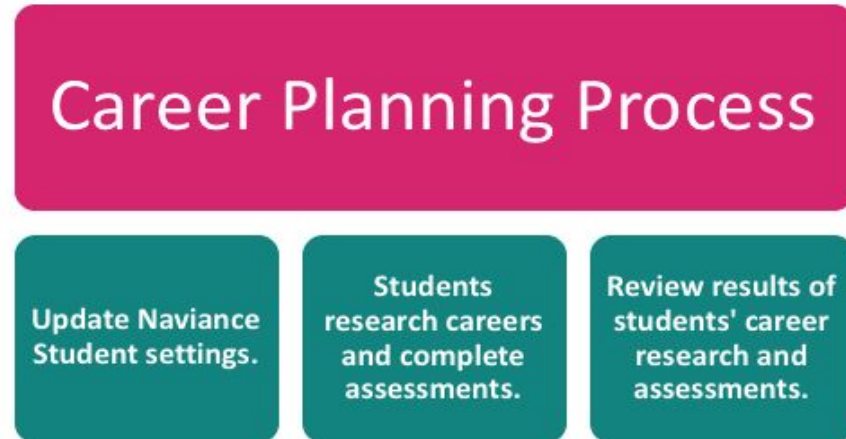

The career planning tools in Naviance allow students to understand how their strengths, goals, skills, and interests can lead to exciting careers.

Self-discovery helps students develop confidence and lays the foundation for their life today, and their future. By uncovering strengths and unique skills, students will see their own potential.

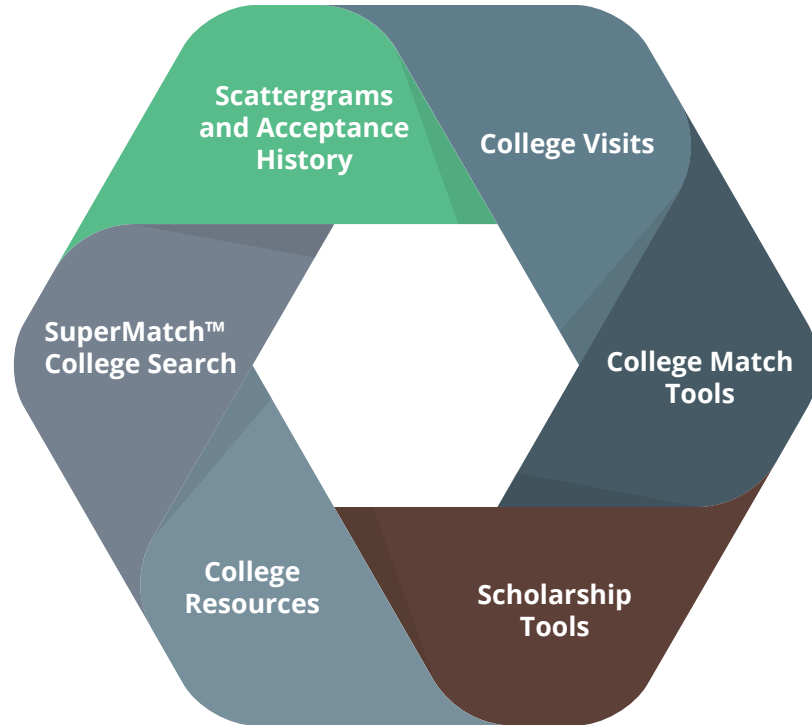

The COVID-19 closures significantly altered our roll out plans for Naviance. Initially, we created 4 grade-level lessons assigned to students for a schedule of completion through varying classes. Current freshmen have PCC so those lessons were completed through that program as it naturally fit within the curriculum. Current 10th, 11th and 12th graders were not assigned activities for completion except for the Career Cluster Finder through the Career Exploration Assignment. As we transition to summer, we want to continue student exposure to the Naviance platform so we're making two activities available for sophomores and juniors. In addition, with Naviance set to take over the college application process for sophomores and juniors, resources will soon be made available.

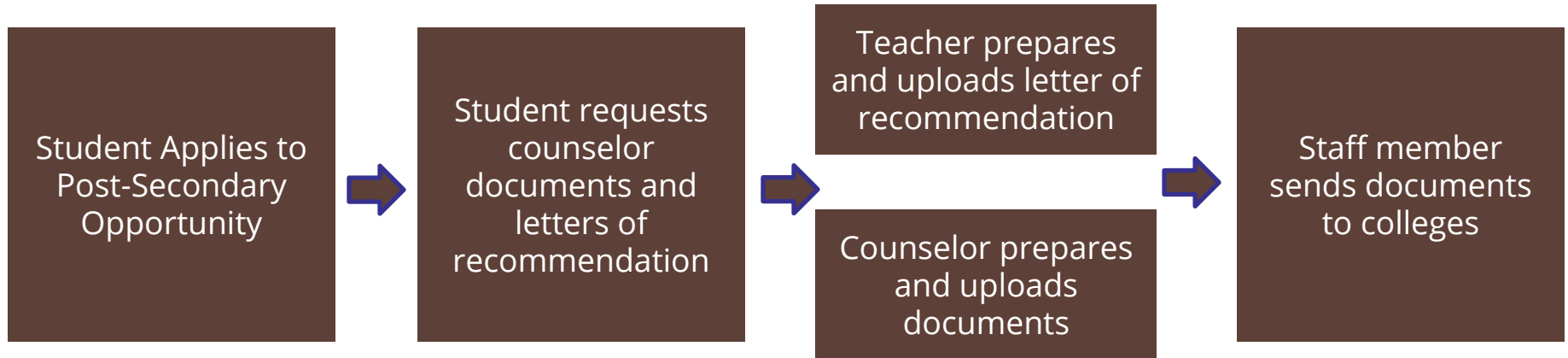
