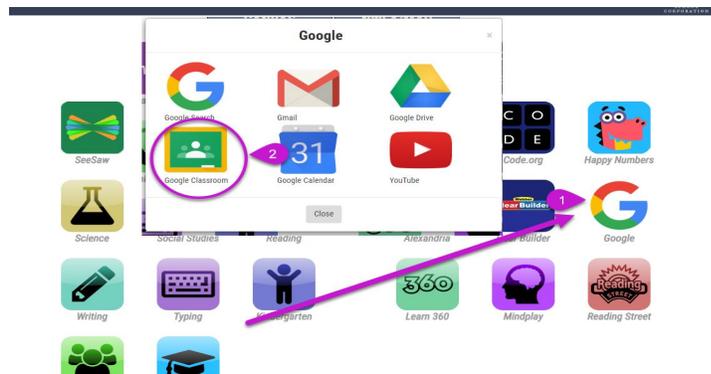


How to Use Google Classroom-for Parents of Elementary Students

Google Classroom is used by Elementary teachers on eLearning Days. The teacher should have communicated with you prior to the day about their expectations and plans for eLearning.

You can reach Google Classroom from the [Primary Launch Pad](#) as shown on the right, or by simply going to [Google.com](https://www.google.com/classroom)



Your child will need to log into Google Classroom with THEIR PHM email.

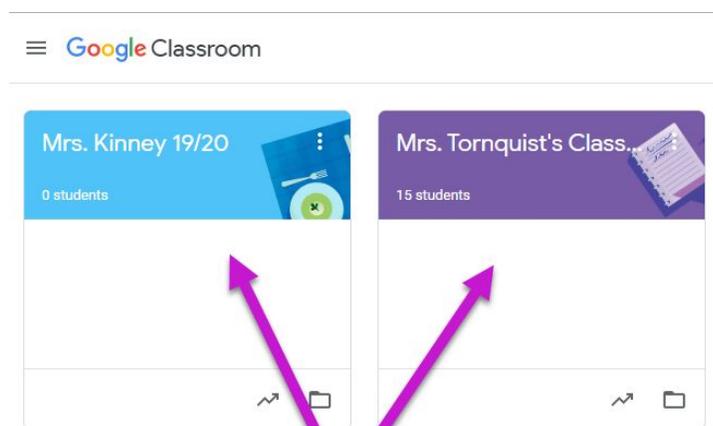
Username: first initial, last name, last three digits of ID number + @phm.k12.in.us
(ex: jsmith456@phm.k12.in.us)

Password: ID number phm (ex: 123456phm)
or first initial + last name + last 3 digits (jsmith456)

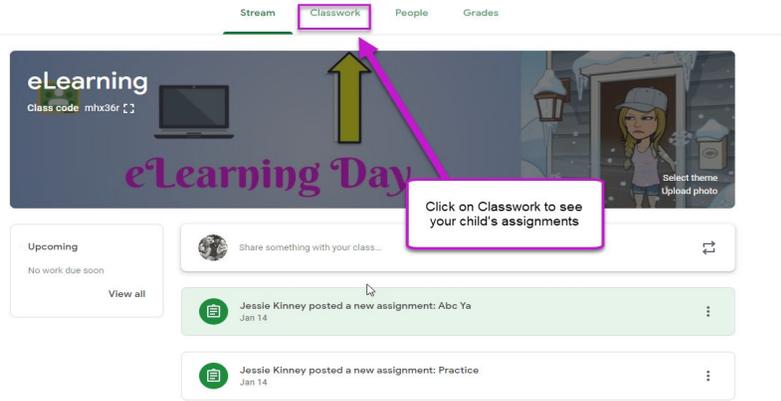
Please note that if you are not seeing your child's Google Classroom, check to make sure that you are signed into the correct Google Account.

Here is an example of what your screen should look like if you logged into Google Classroom correctly.

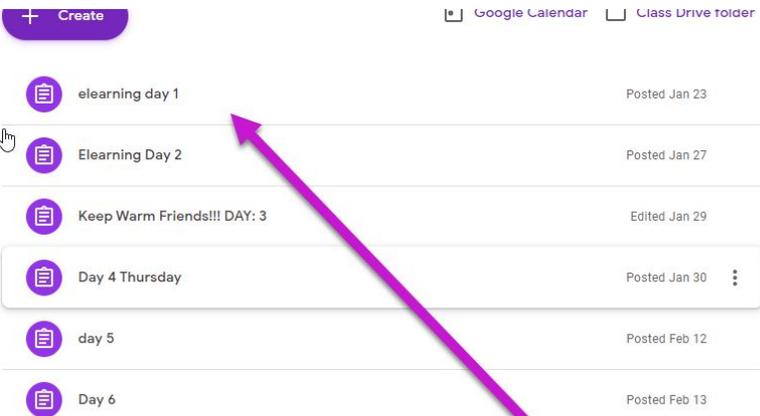
You will need to select the correct Google Classroom that was directed to you!



Once you are in the Google Classroom it will default to Stream, simply click over to CLASSWORK to see your students eLearning assignments.



For the first snow day, have your child complete assignments for day 1. For the second snow day, have your child complete the assignments for day 2, and so on.



If your child is missing a music or PE class on a snow day, he/she should complete the assignments for the missed day. The PE or Music teacher will have provided you with a link to their eLearning platform.

You are not required to print any of the assignments but may do so if you choose.

Work should be turned in to your child's teacher within 5 school days of the missed day
