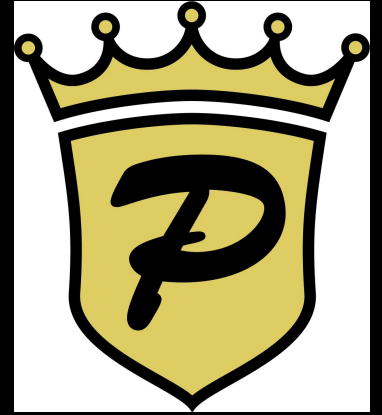

Early College Guiding Goals

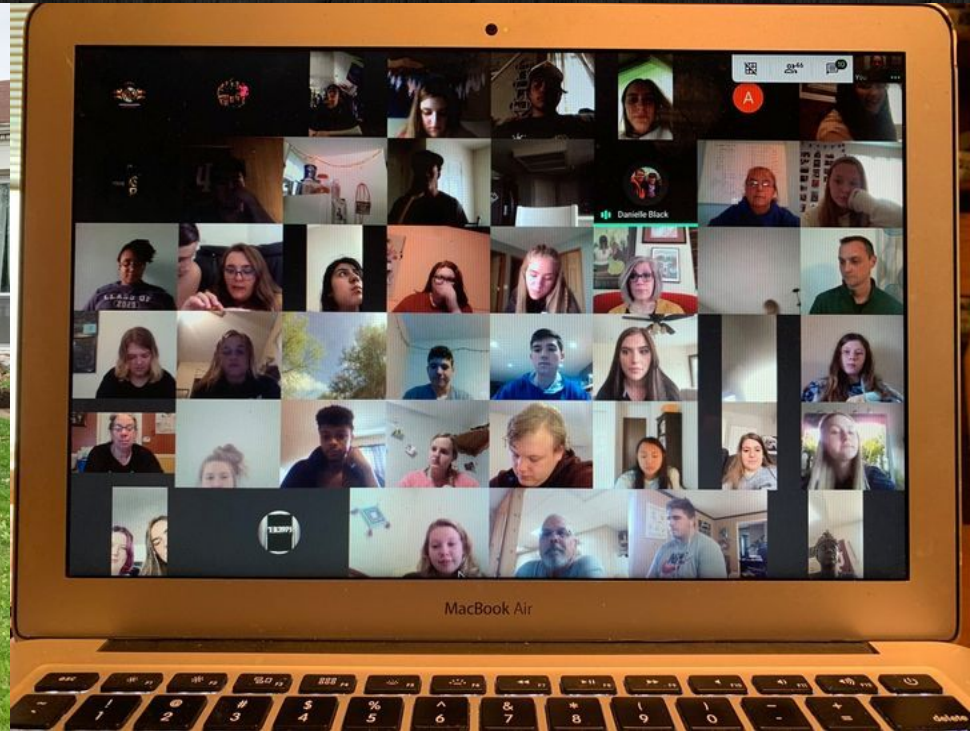
1. Cultivate an environment for relationally dependent students to be successful.

AGS = 63; ICC=21; **100 TOTAL**

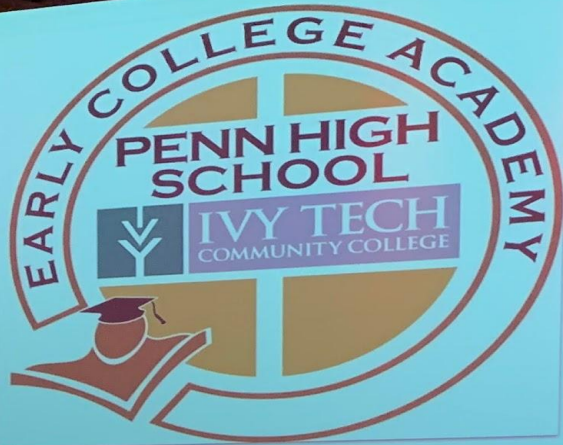

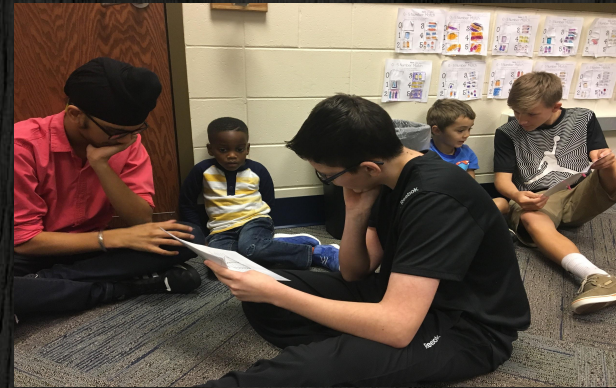
