Per the Public Health Order from the St. Joseph County Health Department, staff and students are required to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth. Students and staff should do their best to practice social distancing, attempting to maintain 6 feet between individuals whenever possible.

CATEGORY	CONSIDERATIONS
Arrival	<ul> <li>OUTDOOR SUPERVISION:</li> <li>Staff will be strategically placed around the building for student safety and supervision.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>BUSES:</li> <li>Upon arrival, buses will unload one at a time with supervision.</li> <li>Students enter the door closest to their classroom. (K, 1, 2 - Door B) (3, 4, 5 Door A).</li> <li>CARS:</li> <li>Survey families and assign them a number.</li> <li>Upon arrival, students will exit their vehicle as directed by staff. Parents are to remain in their vehicles.</li> <li>Students enter the door closest to their classroom. (K, 1, 2 - Door B) (3, 4, 5 - Doors A).</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>UPON ARRIVAL TO CLASSROOMS:</li> <li>Students will wash their hands/utilize hand sanitizer.</li> <li>All materials should be present at school (no backpacks); lunch boxes will remain in a specified location within the classroom.</li> </ul>

Restroom Breaks	<ul> <li>Restroom breaks to be determined by each grade level in a schedule that allows social distancing (K-2; 3-5).</li> <li>Handwashing protocols will be emphasized.</li> <li>Students will follow the same directional movements for entering and exiting (use of arrows/signs).</li> </ul>
Hallway	<ul> <li>Students should stay to the right while in the hallways.</li> <li>When two people meet at a doorway, the person exiting has the "right of way.".</li> <li>Students will maintain 6ft social distancing when walking in line (arm's length).</li> <li>Drinking fountains will be used as bottle filling stations only.</li> </ul>
Classroom Environment	<ul> <li>All furniture impeding social distancing will be removed from the classroom.</li> <li>Shared materials and manipulatives will be sanitized between uses.</li> <li>Provide and label individual student materials and supplies to reduce sharing.</li> <li>Sitspots will be used.</li> <li>Portable/flexible seating allowed/encouraged.</li> </ul> Special Areas: <ul> <li>IMC: Procedures will be put in place to monitor the safe handling of books.</li> <li>PE: Outside when possible.</li> <li>MUSIC: Shared instruments to be sanitized between uses.</li> </ul>
Technology	<ul> <li>Students will be assigned Chromebooks (1:1) and headphones with no common/sharing computers in use.</li> <li>Daily sanitizing of devices.</li> </ul>
Instructional Practices	<ul> <li>Core instruction will include the consideration for learning gaps.</li> <li>Priority given to grade level standards.</li> <li>Consider whole group classroom interventions prior to interim/benchmark testing.</li> <li>Utilize formative assessments.</li> <li>Utilize online formats.</li> <li>K-2 Remediation time scheduled (w/support in literacy).</li> <li>3-5 Remediation/Enrichment time scheduled (w/tech support for enrichment).</li> </ul>

Lunch	<ul> <li>Handwashing protocols will be emphasized both pre &amp; post lunch.</li> <li>The cafeteria and front lobby area will be used for lunch spaces.</li> <li>All seats will be assigned.</li> <li>All lunches are pre-packaged (if purchased at school).</li> <li>All surfaces will be disinfected between groups.</li> </ul>
Recess	<ul> <li>Playground will be divided into sections.</li> <li>Staff will work to create a list of recess game options and activities that promote healthy activity and social distancing.</li> <li>Students will wash their hands/sanitize before and after using the playground.</li> <li>Communal sports equipment (i.e. basketball) will not be available for use.</li> <li>Chromebooks will be utilized during inside recess.</li> </ul>
Dismissal	<ul> <li>Dismissal will be staggered (Kids Club, Car Riders, Bus).</li> <li>Car riders will be exiting using Door E as they will be waiting in the gym. Once their number is called they will be dismissed.</li> <li>Buses will be dismissed by grade level after the bus bell.</li> <li>Students will exit the door nearest their classrooms. (A or B)</li> <li>Parents are to remain in their vehicles during this time.</li> </ul>
