This is an invitation to be a part of a community-sponsored youth basketball league. It is a league developed for the Penn-Harris-Madison Communities and has been given permission to be named the Penn Youth Girls Basketball League. It is a community-based AAU league.

The "Junior" league is open to girls in grades three through six. The "Senior" league is open to grades seven and eight. All those participating in the "Senior" league MUST live in the PHM District or attend a PHM School. The league has attained a rental agreement that will allow practices and games to be held in school facilities within the Penn-Harris-Madison district. The league will begin on September 25th for ALL age groups and end on November 13th with a single elimination tournament for all age groups. All games will be played on Sundays at Penn High School in the Arena, Auxiliary and West Balcony courts. Tournament times may vary on Nov. 13th. Weekly Game Times are:

3rd \& 4th grade league: 12:00-2:00
5th \& 6th grade league: 2:00-4:00
7th \& 8th grade league: 4:00-6:00
The first Sunday, September $25^{\text {th }}$ will be a practice day at Penn High School. The practice day will occur during the specified grade level times above. A parent meeting will also occur on Sept. 25. Games will begin on October 2nd. Regular weekly practices will occur once a week and will begin the week of Sept. 25 th. The cost of the league is $\$ 125.00$ per athlete for $3^{\text {rd }}-8^{\text {th }}$ grade. The coaching staff will be made up of interested parents and community members. This league has assisted in developing and maintaining a winning tradition for the Lady Kingsmen Basketball program. It has also helped to develop numerous NIC conference players, Indiana All-Stars, All-State players and collegiate basketball players.

If you are a hard worker and a team player, we invite you to join the Penn Youth Girls Basketball family and be a part of a winning tradition. If interested please sign-up on September $11^{\text {th }}$ in the Penn Arena from 12:00 to 2:00 pm. Registration form is on the back of this letter. Registering on time is essential to the organization of the league. A late fee of $\$ 10.00$ will be assessed for signing up after September 11th. No sign-ups will be accepted after Friday, September 16th. Early sign-ups are allowed. No refunds will be given after the league begins.

Bring the application form, cash, or check (made payable to Penn Basketball) and your daughter. There will be an athletic representative available if you wish to order a jersey, shirts, shorts, etc. All players need to have a Penn Jersey - this is the only required item you need to purchase if you do not already have one. Please be sure to carefully read all detailed information regarding important dates and times. All parents/guardians will be required to sign a liability waiver and a parent/guardian code of conduct. Players will not be allowed to participate once league games begin, if these forms are not completed.
