

RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTING A TEN DAY QUARANTINE PROTOCOL

WHEREAS, the President of the United States of America has declared a national emergency concerning the 2019 Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020, Governor Eric J. Holcomb issued Executive Order 20-02 declaring a state public health emergency due to COVID-19 and has extended the public health emergency through subsequent Executive Orders;

WHEREAS, the School Corporation’s Staff Return to Work Plan and the Return to Learn: District Overview provided that students and staff who have close contact with a person has COVID-19 should quarantine for fourteen days;

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control has recommended reducing the quarantine period from fourteen days to ten days.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES AS FOLLOWS:

The Superintendent and his designees may amend the Return To Learn: District Overview and Staff Return to Work Plans so that the quarantine period is reduced from fourteen days to ten days in accordance with the recommendations of the Center for Disease Control.
