

# **Return to Learn Plan**

Items in this document are not permanent and will be under a cycle of review.

Per the public health order from the St. Joseph County Health Department, students and staff are required to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth. Students and staff should do their best to practice social distancing, attempting to maintain six feet between individuals whenever possible.

### Arrival

| In an offert to decrease conception of aminal entry will be standard and students   |

| will practice social distancing, entering through multiple doors.   |
| <ul> <li>Bus Riders: Students disembarking from a bus will enter the building<br/>through Doors G, H, I or J and will enter the exterior door closest to their<br/>first class.</li> </ul>  |
| <ul> <li>Car Riders: Students will exit cars from the north end curb to the south<br/>corner curb. Students will exit cars in multiple waves and a stop/slow sign<br/>located at the north curb will direct families. Students will enter the building</li> </ul> |
| through Doors A, C, E, or F and will enter exterior door closest to their first class.  |
| • Walkers: Students walking to school will enter the building through Doors<br>A, C, E, or F and will enter exterior door closest to their first class.   |
| Students are expected to report directly to their classroom to avoid congregating in hallways.  |
| Hallway traffic flow will be strategically designed and marked (and in some cases one-way), to avoid congestion.  |
| Lockers will not be utilized. Students will be allowed to carry a backpack with them  |
| throughout the day in order to have all necessary supplies.   |
| <ul> <li>Limited items will be allowed to be brought to school (chromebook, P.E. clothes, paper, pencil, binders, jackets, books).</li> </ul>   |
| <ul> <li>Breakfast will be delivered to designated areas (grab and go).</li> <li>Students will pick up breakfast and will eat it in classrooms.</li> </ul>  |
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#### **Learning Environment**

- Students will be assigned an individual device for use.
- Drinking fountains will be used as bottle filling stations only.
- Instructional spaces will be arranged to maximize space and repurpose larger rooms.
- Learning materials will not be shared unless sanitization can occur between usage.
- Passing periods will be adjusted as needed to allow students to travel from learning space to learning space while following designed traffic patterns.
  - Passing Periods will be staggered, and students will pass in grade level groups.
- School schedules will be adjusted to a 3 period block schedule day (including advisory/read time) minimizing needed hallway transitions.
  - Block schedule Blue/Gold Days
  - Every other day: Day #1 Periods 1, 2, 3; Day #2 Periods 4, 5, 6

## Lunch

- Students will be directed to wash/sanitize their hands before lunch.
  - An additional wash station will be provided in the commons area for students.
- Individually packaged lunches will be provided in order to minimize students having to congregate in serving lines.
- Lunch will be provided in socially distanced spaces with appropriate protective equipment.
  - Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria.
  - Additional space will be added in order to social distance during lunch.
    - The Commons area will be utilized for lunches along with additional tables and/or seating.
  - Students will have assigned seats.
- Lunch areas will be sanitized after each group.
- Restrooms will be monitored and sanitized regularly.

## Dismissal

- Dismissal will be staggered. Students will be called in groups to exit.
  - Dismissal by grade level in 3 minute increments. This will allow for a reduction of the number of people in the hall while maintaining bus and car rider time.
- Multiple doorways will be used and social distancing will be practiced to avoid congestion.
- Students will exit the door nearest their last classroom at dismissal.
- Car rider procedures will be altered to allow for social distancing.
- Parents are to remain in their vehicles during this time.
