

Return to Learn Plan Principal: Ryan Towner

Items in this document are not permanent and will be under a cycle of review.

Per the public health order from the St. Joseph County Health Department, students and staff are required to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth.

Students and staff should do their best to practice social distancing, attempting to maintain six feet between individuals whenever possible.

CATEGORY	CONSIDERATIONS
Arrival	 Outdoor Supervision: Staff will be strategically placed around the building for student safety and supervision. Bus Riders: Upon arrival, buses will unload 1 at a time with supervision. Students move around the exterior to enter the door closest to their classroom (K - Door A; 1, 2 - Door B; 3, 4, 5 - Doors E). Car Riders: Upon arrival, students will exit their vehicle as directed by supervising staff. Parents are to remain in their vehicles. Students enter the door closest to their classroom (K - Door A; 1, 2 - Door B; 3, 4, 5 - Doors E).
	 Upon Arrival to Classrooms: Students wash their hands/utilize hand sanitizer. Lunch boxes will remain in a specified location within the classroom.
Breakfast	Students who eat breakfast at school will have it delivered to the classroom by Food Services. Students will eat in their classrooms.
Restroom Breaks	 Restroom breaks to be determined by each grade level in a schedule that allows social distancing. Handwashing protocols will be emphasized. Students will follow the same directional movements for entering and exiting (use of arrows).

Hallway	 Students should stay to the right while in the hallways. When two people meet at a doorway, the person exiting has the "right of way.". Students moving in lines will maintain social distancing. There will be a directional flow in the pod areas, and students and staff will "Turn Right!". Drinking fountains will be used as bottle filling stations only.
Classroom Environment	 All furniture impeding social distancing will be removed from the classroom. Shared materials and manipulatives will be sanitized between uses. Determine best use of space which allows social distancing. Sitspots may be used. Portable/flexible seating allowed/encouraged. SPECIAL AREAS: IMC: Procedures will be put in place to monitor the library and allow for safe handling of books. PE: Outside when possible. MUSIC: Shared instruments will be sanitized between use.
Technology	 Students will be assigned Chromebooks (1:1) and headphones with no common/sharing computers in use. Daily sanitizing of devices.
Instructional Practices	 Priority given to grade level standards. Core instruction will include the consideration for learning gaps. Consider whole group classroom interventions prior to interim/benchmark testing. Utilize formative assessments. Utilize online formats.
Lunch	 Handwashing protocols will be emphasized both pre & post lunch. Masks may be removed once students are socially distanced, seated, and ready to eat. The cafeteria and gymnasium may be used for lunch spaces All seats will be assigned. All lunches are pre-packaged (if purchased at school). All surfaces disinfected between groups. Eat outside if weather allows. Entry and exit through specific doors to avoid traffic crossing

Recess	 Playground equipment will be sanitized between uses by grade/class groups. "Ball cart" equipment will not be available. Teachers will collaborate on creating clusters of students, and divide the playground into zones, to help minimize the number of students in one area. All playgrounds will be used to help facilitate disinfecting. Expectation that "inside recess" consists of chromebook use. Students will wash hands after recess.
Dismissal	 Kid's Club will be called first and students will report to the gymnasium. Bus riders will then be dismissed, called by individual bus. Dependent on the number of car riders as evidenced by parent survey data, dismissal options will be evaluated. Parents are to remain in their vehicles during this time.
