### THE COMMENCEMENT TRADITIONS

For hundreds of years, the service which signals the end of a student's formal training has been heralded as a significant one which holds meaning and promise for those students who have successfully completed a prescribed course of study. Even the guilds of the Middle Ages in Europe held a "Commencement" in which apprentices were declared officially trained. It is a time of serious reflection and consideration of a student's educational achievements. While it is a quiet celebration, it should not be one of distracting or unusual behavior, especially in the ceremony itself.

It is our intent to make this service as meaningful as possible. The academic professional of those who have figured in our education is a symbol of those teachers who have tried to bring knowledge to you so that you, too, may build a better life. The "turning of your cap" (tassel) dates back to the middle ages when students who had passed through the Baccalaureate wore their caps backward to indicate they had done so. The graduate processional is a presentation to the world that here are students who are about to enter into the world as trained scholars and workers.

It is our hope that these traditions will remain and hold the same importance that they have always held. It is a significant event in the lives of all students and should be a time of great pride and serious reflection of the past years.

The audience is asked to refrain from standing or leaving the area during the ceremonies. We ask also that cheering, whistling and other demonstrative behavior be omitted in order not to intrude upon the solemnity of this occasion.
