Virtual Option- Description

While we believe that the most effective instruction happens in our classrooms with our highly qualified teachers, we are providing a virtual option. **Please note that this will be a semester commitment and a minimum number of students will be required to offer this option.**



Elementary:

- P-H-M will dedicate a cadre of teachers to take over instructional responsibilities for grades K-5.
- Grade level students will be assigned to a specific teacher and the content will focus on reading, writing, and math.
- Teachers will utilize Google Classroom and will have a combination of live instruction (via zoom/google hangouts) and student work time.
- Students will need to be available for <u>live instruction</u> for a portion of the school day. Instructional feedback and formative assessments will be provided regularly.
- Grade level standards and curriculum maps will align with in-person instruction.

Grades 6-8:

- At the middle school level, students and teachers will utilize Canvas as the learning management tool.
- Students will be assigned to content teachers for language arts, math, social studies, and science.
- Teachers will be in <u>daily contact with students</u> through instructional videos and content. Grade level standards and curriculum maps will align with in-person instruction.

Penn:

- The primary option for high school students who receive coursework at home will be working through Edmentum/Plato (click here for course list).
- This online platform aligns with state and national standards. Students will be assigned to an instructor who will be able to answer their questions and guide them through the coursework.
- Some electives and dual credit courses may not be available virtually, while others may.
