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Response to Suicidal Ideation

ANY statement indicating possible self-harm/suicidal ideation is taken seriously

Structured Screener Administered

Columbia Suicide Severity Rating Scale - Screener

School Psychologists, Counselors, or Administrators administer screener

Results of screening determines next steps



Response to Suicidal Ideation

Caregiver Notification/Involvement

Student's caregiver is always informed/involved

Follow Up

Follow up is always completed

Safety plan written with caregiver, if indicated

Referral

Referral to outside agency may be indicated
